

Code of Conduct

- a. Cheerleaders will conduct themselves properly at all times, especially while at practice, school, or out in public.
- b. Disrespect toward coaches, teammates, or administration will not be tolerated. This includes any form of gossip, and/or aggressive behavior toward someone else.
- c. Cheerleaders will not use undesirable or inappropriate language.
- d. Cheerleaders will display good sportsmanship at ALL times, even when you are not cheering or competing.
- e. Cheerleaders will not smoke, consume or possess alcohol, or use any form of illegal drugs. As a member of the JCS Cheer program you are trusted to make good decisions, as you are a representative of the program, the school, and the community.
- f. While at a competition or game, cheerleaders should be attentive and on their best behavior. They may not leave an event until the end, unless they have discussed it with their coach first, and gotten an OK to do so.
- g. While in your uniform, warm-ups, practice clothing, or any other JCS Cheer apparel you are directly representing this program. ANY inappropriate behavior while wearing JCS Cheer clothing will not be tolerated.
- h. As coaches, we have the discretion to act on each of these issues as we see fit. We have the right to suspend or dismiss a cheerleader at any point for breaking the code of conduct. Each issue will be dealt with on an individual basis and will involve the coach, appropriate administration, and the parents of the cheerleader(s) involved.
