1. Reviewed plans for game programs
  - a. Ads are being sold
  - b. Senior player's well wishes are being collected for the program
  - c. Player's pictures have historically been taken the night of the kick-off. This is not certain as of yet.
  - d. A player rep from each class will be asked to review the program before printing for final feedback.
2. Impact concussion testing is scheduled for Thursday August 11 at 700 AM before practice. Impact testing is suggested every 2 years, therefore all new players to the program should plan to be tested.
3. A second order of Spirit Wear is available until August 14. The code changed from the first order. Check the JHS football website for ordering information.
4. The BBQ for the Seniors and Juniors is planned for August 26 at Bush Lake from 6-9 PM.
5. 4 way scrimmage is set for August 27.
  - a. Freshman will play in Minnetonka
  - b. Sophomore, JV, and Varsity will play in Bloomington.
  - c. Scrimmage is scheduled from 8-12, with Freshman returning around 12:30.
  - d. Host team (Bloomington) needs to provide water for all teams and Gatorade for the Bloomington team. Stavnes' will purchase all drinks and others volunteered to bring coolers and ice. Water is distributed to the visiting teams as they return to their buses.
6. The pool parties are scheduled from 3-5 pm on August 27<sup>th</sup> after the 4 way scrimmage.

- a. Reviewed numbers for Freshman/Sophomore party to determine if they should be split into 2 different locations—for now 1 party is okay
  - b. Need a location for the JV/Varsity pool party yet. Jr and Sr reps were asked to look for a location.
  - c. Each grade needs to provide 3 chaperones for the party. Class reps will find chaperone volunteers.
7. Football social is scheduled for August 27<sup>th</sup> at the Hyland Ski Chalet from 7-11 pm
- a. A flyer is being made to save the date and will be added to the football website.
  - b. Social is for parents, coaches, friends of JHS football, relatives of players, and alumni. Cost is \$10.00 per person
  - c. Silent auction needs more donations. Donations can be dropped off at Seaberg's or Weatherby's. Also need empty baskets to help put together donations or it would be helpful if basket was already put together when dropped off.
8. Need scoreboard operators for home games on the turf field behind Jefferson. Volunteer needs to be trained in the operation.
9. Volunteer positions are posted on the web site.

  - b. Discussed the need for half time oranges sign up. Cyndi will check with Mr. Levy to determine protocol for orange distribution for all teams.
